- Quality of Education:**

Many schools lack basic infrastructure, including toilets and drinking water, which hinders the quality of education.
- Teacher Shortage:**

There is a significant shortage of teachers, particularly in rural areas, leading to large class sizes and inadequate supervision.

Recommendations

The government should prioritize increasing enrollment, especially for girls, and improve the quality of education by ensuring adequate infrastructure and teacher recruitment.
